The Chamber also serves as the Mendocino County Film Office, helping film industry professionals identify locations and navigate the permit process. Our extensive familiarity and knowledge of the county has been instrumental in bringing commercials, television, and film projects to our region. DAY TRIPS IN AND AROUND MENDOCINO COUNTY

- Anderson Valley wineries
- Point Arena Lighthouse and Coast Highway 1 scenic drive
- Kayaking one of the local rivers or a sea caves tour
- Horseback riding, hiking or biking into the redwoods or along coastal trails

If you have four days... How about a scenic drive and walk through the redwoods?

- Drive through a redwood tree in Leggett (one-hour drive north, one-way)
- Montgomery Woods State National Reserve (a beautiful one and one-half hour drive one-way from Fort Bragg)

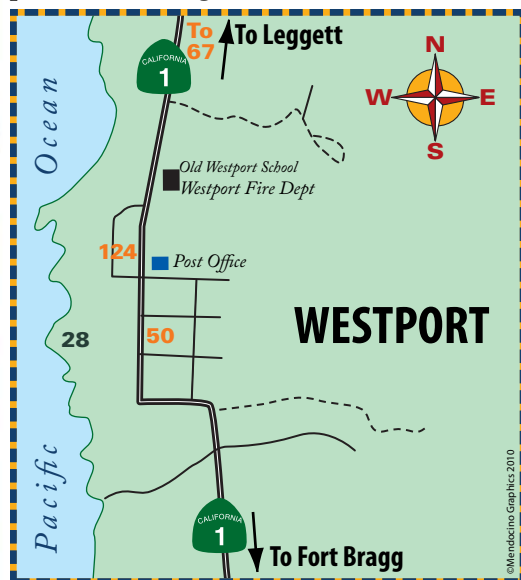
WESTPORT

BLINK AND YOU'LL MISS the downtown. But slow down and you'll find a store for picnic supplies, a hotel that offers meals and lodging, and an area rich in logging history. An active local community, organized as the Westport Village Society, wants to make sure their town and history aren't forgotten. Each year, the Westport Village Society sponsors the Mother's Day Rubber Ducky Race. The Westport Volunteer Fire Department hosts lively barbecues and other events during the year.

The beaches, big cliffs and state parks north and south of Westport provide 180-degree ocean views that are nothing short of spectacular. On

a clear day you can see the Lost Coast to the north and Fort Bragg headlands to the south. From here, Highway 1 heads north for six more miles before it turns inland toward Highway 101.

POPULATION: 14,799

SURROUNDED BY the spectacular natural beauty of northern California's redwood forests and the Pacific Ocean, Fort Bragg is an ideal destination for both visitors and small businesses. Located in historic Mendocino County, it is the largest town on the scenic coast between San Francisco and Eureka. This growing, prosperous city offers a unique blend of natural resources, recreation, and scenery.

Fort Bragg, once a booming logging town, is now a hub for state parks and reserves. The area's Mendocino Coast Botanical Gardens is one of only two such gardens in the continental United States fronting directly on an ocean.

The famous Skunk Train takes visitors from Fort Bragg or Willits on a route through the redwoods that is accessible only by railroad. Those looking for special adventures will find that Fort Bragg's location offers an array of appealing activities including whale watching, sport fishing, kayaking, and beachcombing,

along with bird-watching, horseback riding, hiking and biking.

Art galleries showcase local artists, and craftspeople and antique shops offer unexpected finds. Couples know that the town, with its wide variety of venues, is the perfect place to have a romantic wedding and honeymoon.

FORT BRAGG

IN THE EARLY 20TH CENTURY, Fort Bragg residents threw their household garbage—glass, bottles, appliances, and even vehicles—over the cliffs above what is Glass Beach, now part of MacKerricher State Park. The land was owned at that time by the Union Lumber Company and locals referred to the spot as “The Dump.” Clean-up of the larger metallic waste occurred in the late 2000s, and you can still see remnants of water-washed broken glass in the pocket beaches at the end of Elm Street. Please take only photographs; leave the glass for all to enjoy.



MOVIE TRIVIA

FILMMAKERS HAVE HAD A LOVE AFFAIR with Mendocino County for more than 100 years, beginning in 1904 with Caspar Lumber Company's *The Sequoia Sempervirens* (Redwoods). What is the attraction? It's our diversity. It's the place where blue-green waters form tranquil bays, rivers and streams wander to the sea interrupted by an occasional waterfall, and rocky headlands hug the Pacific Ocean.

Some of the more well-known contemporary films shot in and

around Fort Bragg are 1979's *Humanoids from the Deep* (locations in and around Fort Bragg), 1987's *Overboard* (film locations include Noyo Harbor, and Fort Bragg's Veteran's Hall) starring Goldie Hawn and Kurt Russell; and 2001's *The Majestic*, starring Jim Carrey (film locations at Point Cabrillo Light Station and the Skunk Train depot).

MENDOCINO is situated on a peninsula and surrounded on three sides by picturesque wildflower-covered bluffs and crashing surf. Established in the 1850s, many of the New England-style Victorians here have been lovingly restored into romantic bed-and-breakfast inns, world class restaurants and quaint shops.

Best known as Cabot Cove, Maine, in the TV show "*Murder, She Wrote*", the town is actually a National Historic Preservation District. A brochure to guide you on a walking tour of historic houses is available on Main Street at the Ford House, the visitor center for the Mendocino Headlands State Park. Guides can also be obtained at the Kelley House Museum on Albion Street and the Mendocino Coast Chamber of Commerce Visitor Center in Fort Bragg.

Big River Beach, below town, is a popular spot for walking, and it's a great place to view or photograph spectacular sunsets. A state park trail east along Big River is popular for watching wildlife, walking, running, and riding bicycles and horses. You can also paddle upriver for miles in a kayak or canoe.

Just north of Mendocino is Point Cabrillo Light Station State Historic Park with a working lighthouse, marine exhibit, gift shop and two museums.

FATHER TIME AND THE MAIDEN: One of the most frequently asked questions is, “What is the statue on top of the bank building?” For all who have wondered, but never asked, here it is.

Erick Albertson is credited with building the Masonic Temple (now housing The Savings Bank of Mendocino County) and carving “Father Time and the Maiden” from a single piece of virgin redwood. The statuary consists of the Angel of Death, the Hourglass of Transience, the Weeping Maiden, the Anointment of Her Hair, the Acacia Branch in one hand and the Sacred Urn in the other, the Sundered Column, and The Book of Light. All drawn from mythology, these symbolize a particular rite of passage within the Masonic Order.

It took Albertson seven years to complete the building and statue. However, the long timeline had much to do with the fact that Albertson was working full time at the lumber mill and that building funds were difficult to come by during the Civil War period.



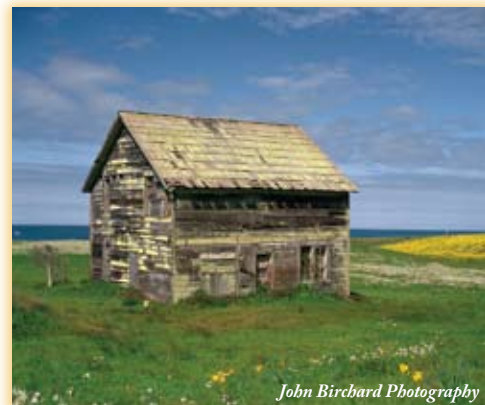
JUST TWO MILES SOUTH of Mendocino, Little River offers an award-winning nine-hole golf course with ocean views, plus world-class inns and restaurants along a short stretch of Highway 1. Little River is also home to Van Damme State Park which includes one of the handful of pygmy forests in the entire world, as well as a sandy beach that serves as a launching point for abalone divers and sea kayakers.

Comptche, just up the road, is the gateway to remote Montgomery Woods State Park, a 1,142 acre preserve that contains both coast and Sierra redwoods, as well as an excellent three-mile-long hike.

A few miles south, the village of Albion has a unique personality, a place with its own history and community. A portion of the community is known locally as “the Albion Nation”.

In addition to a passionate community, there is a market, hardware store, volunteer fire department, post office, a weekly farmer’s market, some great restaurants, a cliffside inn, a llama ranch, and a small commercial fishing operation at the mouth of the Albion River, which also offers camping facilities, kayak and canoe rentals, and

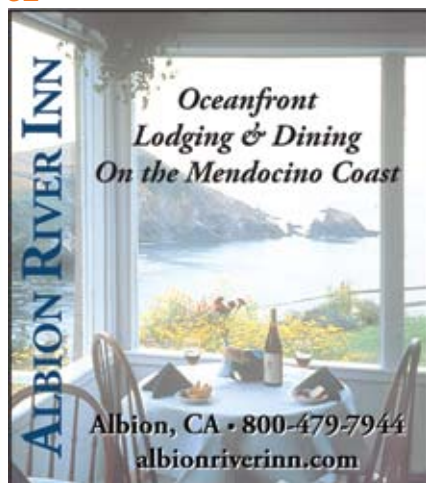

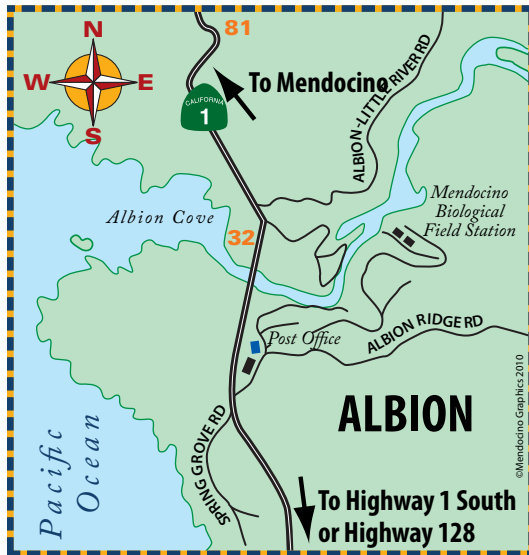

Located between the towns of Elk and Mendocino, Albion had its start in 1853 when English sea captain William Richardson built a home and a sawmill. Although the mill was active for some seventy-five years, the town remained small.

Albion is home to the last wooden bridge in operation along the Pacific Coast Highway, the Albion River Bridge, which was constructed from salvaged timber during World War II and stands 174 feet above sea level.



HISTORY FAST FACTS...

THE LITTLE RIVER POST OFFICE opened in 1865, changed its name to Littleriver in 1894, closed in 1929, and re-opened as Little River in 1930.

THE FIRST SAWMILL IN ALBION was powered by a tide-driven water wheel. The mill was destroyed its first winter by high ocean waves. William Richardson rebuilt the mill, powering it with steam instead of the ocean.

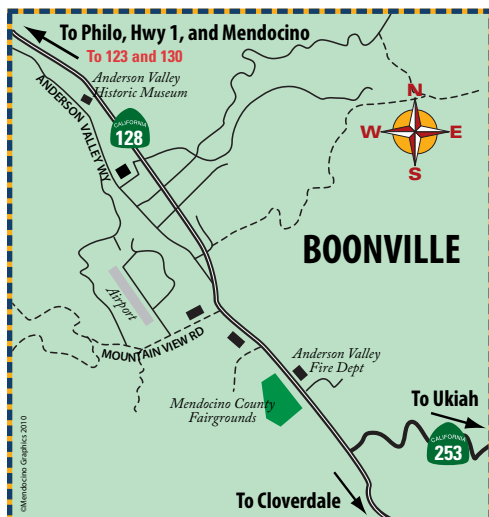

The drive in and through the valley is one of the most breathtaking in California, moving from rolling, oak-covered hills in the east, to pastureland, vineyards and orchards in the valley proper, and culminating in towering redwoods at the west end, then opening out to the vast Pacific Ocean.

ELK / POINT ARENA

POPULATION: 426 / 1,258

ELK IS THE BEST-KEPT SECRET on the Mendocino Coast. In a few short blocks are inns, restaurants, a community center and post office, shops, a history museum, state park and spectacular sea stacks with views that rival California's Big Sur coast. Elk is known for its romance, and many couples choose to hold their wedding here.

South of Elk, the village of Manchester lies in an area of rich grazing land, where flocks of sheep and herds of cattle add a pastoral note to some of the most spectacular coastal scenery in the world. A county road north of Manchester leads past Manchester KOA Campground to Manchester State Beach. You can walk for miles between the surf and sand dunes.

POINT ARENA, the county's smallest incorporated city, offers lodging, restaurants, shops, a community library, a campground, and the Art Deco-style Arena Theatre. Arena Cove is home to the Point Arena fishing pier where local fishermen bring their catch.

The 105-foot-high Point Arena Lighthouse, with its giant first-order Fresnel lens, is a popular backdrop for photographers. On your way to the lighthouse (on Lighthouse Road) stop and walk along the cliffs in the Stornetta Land Trust open space. About a half-mile north are some former Coast Guard homes. Just before you get there, turn back and look down at the waterfall pouring into the ocean.

GUALALA IS MENDOCINO COUNTY'S gateway from the south, bordering Sonoma County along the Gualala River. Although just a few blocks long, this quintessential coastal town is a vibrant artist's colony focused around the Gualala Arts Center. While there are exhibits at the Arts Center year-round, local artists have an annual tradition of opening their studios for public tours, offering a behind-the-scenes look at their work and their creative processes.

At the town's south end, a big sandy beach is sandwiched between the outlet of the Gualala River and the Pacific Ocean. The river offers a perfect place to canoe or kayak. Gualala Regional Park is a sanctuary with a wildlife lookout and visitor center, and provides expansive coastal views and quiet walks.

There are numerous galleries, supermarkets and restaurants clustered along the approximately one mile stretch of Highway One that makes up the largest portion of Gualala's business district.
